This project was submitted to the KAWS Three Rivers Chapter and consisted of stabilizing a section of the Black Vermillion River with re-sloping of the bank, installation of rock weirs and replanting of native vegetation. The area is directly adjacent to a county road which is in jeopardy of being lost due to bank erosion. The cost is estimated at \$10,943 with \$3,500 approved for funding through the PMT. Partners include the Marshall County Conservation District, SCC and Bigelow Township. The project was visited by the Chapter as part of an educational tour on April 11, 2002.
