## Black Vermillion Marsh Project

This project was submitted to the KAWS Three Rivers Chapter and is located on the Tuttle Creek Wildlife Area and involves the development of an 89-acre wetland. It is located directly below an existing 50-acre wetland that has a pumping unit. Construction involved the development of a 6,000 foot low level dike with an outlet structure to allow for water level control. This is a conversion of an existing crop field into a wetland with a buffer. The total project cost was estimated at \$38,000 with \$20,000 approved by the PMT. Other partners include the KS Dept. of Wildlife and Parks and the US Fish and Wildlife Service. This project was also viewed as part of the Chapters educational tour held on April 11, 2002.
