This is a second educational demonstration project placed on the Smoky Hill River to help launch a multi-county initiative submitted to the Lower Ark Chapter. The project involves stabilizing around 600 feet of stream bank to include wiers, vanes and slope grade work, plus the establishment of new native vegetation on the bank and buffer area. The project was estimated at \$11,000 of which \$10,000 was approved for funding by the PMT. Partners include the McPherson County Conservation District, State Conservation Commission, K-State Research and Extension and the landowner. Project under construction at press time.
