## Larry Dahlsten Stabilization Project

### Project Profile

**Landowner:** Larry Dahlsten  
**Location:** McPherson County  
**Focus Area:** Smoky Hill River  
**Habitat Restoration:** 1200 feet of streambank  
**Project Year:** 2003  
**Project Cost:** \$24,328



This is a multi-county demonstration project on the Smoky Hill River that was submitted to the KAWS Lower Ark Chapter that will be utilized to help stimulate interest within the watershed to address water quality issues. The project involves the stabilization of 1,200 feet of stream bank which will include re-sloping of the existing bank, placement of seven weirs to stabilize the toe and re-establishment of the native vegetation on the bank and buffer area. The total project is estimated at \$24,328 with \$13,068 approved by the PMT. Partners include the landowner, State Conservation Commission, K-State Research and Extension and McPherson County Conservation District.
