This project was submitted by Tom Bowman, Area Wildlife Biologist for KDWP, to the Three Rivers Chapter and is restoring an eight-acre wetland that has silted in. The project is located adjacent to Interstate 70 in Geary County with an estimated cost of \$15,000. The PMT has approved the expenditure of \$11,000 toward the cost of the project. The project will involve the removal of silt to deepen the wetland, make a viewing area parking lot and two habitat mounds. Partners include the Geary County Conservation District, NRCS, Roy Fausnett and KS Dept. of Wildlife and Parks.
