Perry Pheasants Forever Wetland Project

Project Profile

Location: Jefferson County
Focus Area: Perry Reservoir
Habitat Restoration: 3-acres of wetlands (2 cells)
Project Year: 2002
Project Cost: \$47,790



The project was submitted by the Greg Johnson of Pheasants Forever to the Glacial Hills Chapter and is located directly adjacent to the Perry Reservoir. It involves the development of two small wetlands of about three acres, a 20-acre native grass buffer and handicap-accessible trail system for youth education. The PMT approved spending \$5,000 to assist with development of the two wetlands. The total cost of the project was estimated at \$47,790 with the remaining costs supplied by KS Dept. of Wildlife and Parks, US Fish and Wildlife Service, KS Dept. of

Health and Environment, Westar Energy, John Dewey Learning Academy, National Wildlife Federation and the Turner Foundation. An educational tour of the site was provided by Pheasants Forever on June 20, 2002 as part of the Glacial Hills Chapter meeting.
