Project Profile

Landowner: Sac and Fox Nation

Location: Jackson County

Focus Area: Sac and Fox Casino

Habitat Restoration: Four wetland cells

Project Year: 2003

Project Cost: \$23,300



This project was submitted to the Glacial Hills Chapter and consists of creating four wetland cells through the enhancement of existing terraces. The tertiary water from the Sac and Fox Casino wastewater treatment facility is diverted through the wetlands to help clean the water further before it is allowed to run into the stream. They will monitor the water quality before and after it goes through the wetland to determine the benefits received by filtering it through wetland cells. The cost of the project is estimated at \$23,300 with the PMT approving \$15,000 for funding assistance through the grant. An educational tour of the site was provided by the Sac and Fox tribe on April 18, 2002 as part of the Glacial Hills Chapter meeting.
