This project was submitted to the KAWS Eastern I-70 Chapter. It consisted of constructing a fence along 3,232 feet of Middle Creek to prevent livestock from entering the creek. The project protected 11 acres of riparian buffer and is located in a high FCB area and will ultimately protect 24 acres of riparian area.



The project is located in the SE1/4 of S1-T18-R19. The total project cost was \$6,674 and KAWS contributed \$3,999 to help get the project completed and on the ground. The picture above is looking to the north and the fence turns at the north tree line and runs west as part of the project. As you can see by the trees there is a healthy riparian area. The picture to the left is looking south with riparian area to the left and pasture to the right.
